Resolution No. P-22 RESOLUTION OPPOSING NEW YORK STATE ASSEMBLY BILL A2222

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body has long endeavored to protect the rights and advocate for the best interests of those who live in this great county; and

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body has advocated for the youth of Rensselaer County in all endeavors, including the encouragement of team building, sportsmanship and self-reliance; and

WHEREAS, High schools in Eastern Rensselaer County have supported successful membership in the New York State High School Clay Target League (NYSHSTCL); and

WHEREAS, The NYSHSTCL fosters healthy competition and opportunities for co-ed and adaptive student athletes, as many shooting ranges are handicapped accessible; and

WHEREAS, High School participation is sponsored by fundraising and local businesses and clubs; and

WHEREAS, Safety is the first priority of the club, with all student athletes and coaches required to attend a New York State Hunter Education course before participation in practice or competition; and

WHEREAS, Manhattan Assembly member Linda B. Rosenthal has introduced Legislation (Assembly Bill A2222) that would outlaw the NYSHSTCL and, as a result, the safe and supervised practice of shooting sports in high schools; and

WHEREAS, Rensselaer County students choosing to exercise their rights under the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution would improperly discriminated against; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body does hereby oppose New York State Assembly Bill A.2222; and be it, further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of this Legislative Body is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to all the Rensselaer County Sportsman's Club's and their representatives: Governor Andrew Cuomo, State Senator Daphne Jordan, State Senator Neil Breslin, Assemblyman Jake Ashby and Assemblyman John
